## Ashlar stones of the district Saalfeld-Rudolstadt (part 2)

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## **Abstract**

In the northern part of the district Saalfeld-Rudolstadt sand- and limestones of Younger Paleozoic and Triassic age were excavated in small stone quarries. Until the beginning of the  $20^{th}$  century they were used as broken, cut and building stones. From middle age to the end of the  $19^{th}$  century sandstones of Volpriehausen (area Rudolstadt) and Sollig-Sequence (area Gölitz-Bad Blankenburg) were being important, too.
